





Their name: Vermont Independence Day.





The earthquake occurred on 12 January 2010 approximately 25 kilometres (16 mi) WSW from the country's capital Port-au-Prince at 16:53 UTC-5^[3] on the Enriquillo-Plantain Garden fault system. 4 The earthquake was measured a magnitude of 7.0 M_w earthquake and was followed by a series of aftershocks, fourteen of them between magnitudes 5.0 and 5.9. The main areas affected by the quake were Port-au-Prince and its suburbs, though it was also felt in several surrounding countries and regions, including Cuba, Jamaica, Puerto Rico, and the bordering country of Dominican Republic. In spite of this, casualties from the earthquake were only

reported in Haiti.

Tectonic Summary

The January 12, 2010, Haiti earthquake occurred in the boundary region separating the Caribbean plate and the North America plate. This plate boundary is dominated by left-lateral strike slip motion and compression, and accommodates about 20 mm/y slip, with the Caribbean plate moving eastward with respect to the North America plate.

Haiti occupies the western part of the island of Hispaniola, one of the Greater Antilles islands, situated between Puerto Rico and Cuba. At the longitude of the January 12 earthquake, motion between the Caribbean and North American plates is partitioned between two major eastwest trending, strike-slip fault systems -- the Septentrional fault system in northern Haiti and the Enriquillo-Plantain

Dominican Republic aid to Haiti eases historic tensions January 13, 2010 10:01 p.m. EST

(CNN) -- The Dominican Republic was the first country to give aid to Haiti in the aftermath of Tuesday's devastating earthquake. Some of the first video images of the Haitian capital of Port-au-Prince came from a Dominican television crew.

On the face of it, the quick reaction from Haiti's neighbor may not seem surprising given their proximity. **But historically, a much wider gap in relations has existed between Haiti and the Dominican Republic since colonial times.** The Dominican Republic's outpouring of support to Haiti is a reminder of how the less-than-friendly legacy between the two nations has been buried even deeper.

Some tensions still exist between citizens of both countries. Dominicans recall how they were under Haitian rule for a period in the mid-1800s, and how they repeatedly fought Haitian aggressions. Today, Haitians provide cheap labor in the Dominican Republic, a trend that has caused resentment on both sides, not unlike the illegal immigration debate in the United States.

The Massachusetts Special Election and Health Reform

The special U.S. Senate election in Massachusetts is causing a stir as Congress hussles to wrap up its landmark health overhaul legislation.

Taliban suicide attack kills CIA agents at US outpost in Afghanistan

The CIA yesterday vowed to avenge the deaths of seven of its agents who were killed in a suicide bombing on Wednesday in Afghanistan, as it emerged that the bomber may have been invited on to the base as a potential informant according to two former US officials.


"This attack will be avenged through successful, aggressive counterterrorism operations," a US intelligence official said on condition of anonymity.

One former senior intelligence official said the bomber was being courted as an informant and that it was the first time he had been brought inside the camp. An experienced CIA debriefer came from Kabul for the meeting, suggesting the purpose was to gain intelligence, the official said.

Seven agents died, including the base's female chief, a mother of three, former CIA officials told AP. Six others were injured in the attack on Forward Operating Base Chapman in eastern Afghanistan, near Khost. One of the dead was reported to be Harold Brown Jr, according to his father, Harold Brown Sr. The elder Brown said Thursday that his 37-year-old son, who grew up in Bolton, Massachussetts, served in the army and worked for the state department. He is survived by a wife and three children ages 12, 10 and 2.

Fort Hood shooting suspect Maj. Nidal Malik Hasan permanently paralyzed from chest down, says lawyer

Maj. Nidal M. Hasan, the alleged Fort Hood gunman recuperating from the gunshot wounds that ended the murderous rampage, is expected to be permanently paralyzed from the chest down, his lawyer said

Hasan, the Army psychiatrist charged with killing 13 people in the Nov. 5 massacre, "has no sensation from the nipple area down," Hasan's civilian attorney, John P. Galligan, told the Washington Post.

Galligan said Hasan has been told the paralysis is permanent.

The attorney participated Saturday in an hour-long, closed-door hearing in an intensive care room at Brooke Army Medical Center, where a magistrate ruled that the Hasan will be held until he can be transferred to jail.

"In the middle of this hearing, he started to nod off and go to sleep," Galligan said. "When I've spoken with him, he's coherent, but your ability to have any meaningful exchange with him is limited in time and subject."

Gates says Fort Hood review exposes problems

WASHINGTON - Defense Secretary Robert Gates says an internal Pentagon policy review stemming from the Fort Hood massacre "raises serious questions" about the military's ability to cope with security threats within its ranks.

Speaking to reporters at the Pentagon Friday, Gates said he could not talk in detail about elements of the review involving Army Maj. Nidal Hasan, the man suspected in the mass shootings at the Texas military base last year.

Gates did say the review shows that "it is clear that as a department we have not done enough to adapt to the evolving internal security threat." The secretary also said it demonstrates that the Pentagon "is burdened by 20th century processes and attitudes mostly rooted in the Cold War."


As many as eight Army officers could face discipline for failing to do anything when the alleged shooter in the Fort Hood rampage displayed erratic behavior early in his military career, two officials familiar with the case said.

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Climategate: You should be steamed

If you have not heard, hackers penetrated the computers of the Climate Research Unit, or CRU, of the United Kingdom's University of East Anglia, exposing thousands of e-mails and other documents. Many of the exchanges were between top mainstream climate scientists in Britain and the U.S. who are closely associated with the authoritative (albeit controversial) IPCC. Among the more troubling revelations were data adjustments enhancing the perception that man is causing global warming through the release of carbon dioxide (CO2) and other atmospheric greenhouse gases

Climategate Continued
Particularly disturbing was the way the core IPCC scientists (the believers) marginalized
the skeptics of the theory that man-made global warming is large and potentially
catastrophic. The e-mails document that the attack on the skeptics was twofold. First,
the believers gained control of the main climate-profession journals. This allowed them
to block publication of papers written by the skeptics and prohibit unfriendly peer
review of their own papers. Second, the skeptics were demonized through false labeling
and false accusations.

Climate alarmists would like you to believe the science has been settled and all respectable atmospheric scientists support their position. The believers also would like you to believe the skeptics are involved only because of the support of Big Oil and that they are few in number with minimal qualifications.

But who are the skeptics? A few examples reveal that they are numerous and well-qualified. Several years ago two scientists at the University of Oregon became so concerned about the overemphasis on man-made global warming that they put a statement on their Web site and asked for people's endorsement; 32,000 have signed the petition, including more than 9,000 Ph.Ds. More than 700 scientists have endorsed a 231-page Senate minority report that questions man-made global warming. The Heartland Institute has recently sponsored three international meetings for skeptics. More than 800 scientists heard 80 presentations in March. They endorsed an 881-page document, created by 40 authors with outstanding academic credentials, that challenges the most recent publication by the IPCC.

Climategate Continued- What do the skeptics believe?

What do the skeptics believe? First, they concur with the believers that the Earth has been warming since the end of a Little Ice Age around 1850. The cause of this warming is the question. Believers think the warming is man-made, while the skeptics believe the warming is natural and contributions from man are minimal and certainly not potentially catastrophic \tilde{A} la Al Gore.


Second, skeptics argue that CO2 is not a pollutant but vital for plant life. Numerous field experiments have confirmed that higher levels of CO2 are positive for agricultural productivity. Furthermore, carbon dioxide is a very minor greenhouse gas. More than 90 percent of the warming from greenhouse gases is caused by water vapor. If you are going to change the temperature of the globe, it must involve water vapor.

Third, and most important, skeptics believe that climate models are grossly overpredicting future warming from rising concentrations of carbon dioxide. We are being told that numerical models that cannot make accurate 5- to 10-day forecasts can be simplified and run forward for 100 years with results so reliable you can impose an economic disaster on the U.S. and the world.

Climategate Concluded

The revelation of Climategate occurs at a time when the accuracy of the climate models is being seriously questioned. Over the last decade Earth's temperature has not warmed, yet every model (there are many) predicted a significant increase in global temperatures for that time period. If the climate models cannot get it right for the past 10 years, why should we trust them for the next century?

Climategate reveals how predetermined political agendas shaped science rather than the other way around. It is high time to question the true agenda of the scientists now on the hot seat and to bring skeptics back into the public debate.

Geithner, AIG and the need for Fed Transparency

Last week it was revealed that when Treasury Secretary Tim Geithner was Chairman of the New York Federal Reserve, he urged AIG officials not to disclose to the Securities Exchange Commission relevant details of agreements with banks to bail out Goldman Sachs. Apparently he felt at the time that regulators and the public would be angry that taxpayer money was used to fully compensate bankers who made some horrifically bad investment decisions. These banks should have suffered the consequences of the huge risks they were taking. After all, they kept plenty of rewards when times were good. Instead, the Fed found a way to socialize these major losses so these banks could survive and continue making more bad decisions, at the expense of the American people and the value of the dollar.

Geithner claims that they had to take politically unpopular actions to save the economy from collapse. Half of that is right – it was politically unpopular, but it is extremely premature at best, to claim the economy has been saved. It was just reported that 85,000 more jobs in December. Unemployment stands at 10% officially, and 22% according to more traditional calculations. It is hard to argue that this sort of government waste has done anything but harm to our economy. Raiding Main Street to bail out Wall Street is a foolish idea. Main Street productivity and the strength of the dollar is the bedrock of the economy. You cannot gut this foundation without eventually toppling everything else. This is what too many policy makers either don't understand or refuse to face. Or even worse, perhaps they do understand, but don't care!

"My determination to achieve this goal is only heightened when I see reports of massive profits and obscene bonuses at some of the very firms who owe their continued existence to the American people, folks who have not been made whole and who continue to face real hardship in this recession," Obama said.

China executes rogue trader, millions still missing

BEIJING (Reuters) – China on Tuesday executed a former securities trader for embezzlement, the first person in the industry to be put to death, but millions of yuan are still missing, a state newspaper said.

Yang Yanming was sentenced to death in late 2005 and took the secret of the whereabouts of 65 million yuan (\$9.52 million) of the misappropriated funds to his grave, the Beijing Evening News said.

The report added that Yang was the first person working in China's securities sector to be executed.

"Preserve your moral integrity and don't set too much store by business results," Yang told the newspaper before the sentence was carried out.

He was the general manager of the Beijing securities trading department of the China Great Wall Trust and Investment Corp., which became Galaxy Securities, from 1997 to 2003.

Conscious that the growing gap between rich and poor could generate resentment, China is battling corruption and stock trading abuses. It has used the death penalty as a deterrent in serious cases.





CHIP BERLET: Well, if you just say, "Look, they're all crazy, they're all nuts, we don't have to pay any attention to them, and they're not real," that does several things. One is that it obscures this dynamic that's occurring that Lenny Zeskind explained so well, that there's a struggle going on in these right-wing movements right now, and white supremacist organizers are trying to pull the tea bag movement way towards more aggression and a more ideological position.

But also, I talked to organizers who said when they try and reach out to white communities, where they have in the past had some traction around issues like immigration or issues like racism or even organizing around the political economy and the environment, that they're getting doors slammed in their face, because, you know, people can hear the Democrats and—I'm sorry, but the Keith Olbermanns and the Rachel Maddows making fun of their neighbors and them, and they don't want to hear from progressive organizers.

CHIP BERLET: Well, I think that if you're looking at it in terms of a society, people need to stand up and say this is way out of control, that whenever you have this kind of anger and demonization and scapegoating, it's very toxic to democracy. And I wrote a report called "Toxic to Democracy" to explain how that works.

The other thing is that Democrats really have to stop this snide and smug and arrogant, you know, "haha, let's laugh at the rednecks and rubes" stance, because, you know, first of all, the political right has out-organized centrist Democrats repeatedly since 1980. So I have no idea why they're laughing on the Democratic Party side. And the other thing these inside-the-Beltway spin doctors who say, you know, "It's OK to call them the radical religious right, the political extremists, they're crazy"—you know, this whole theory that came out of the '50s and '60s that these people are psychologically maladjusted has been repudiated in social science. So, you know, there are people being pulled into the right-wing populist and white supremacist movement that skillful, progressive organizers and labor organizers could be bringing into a multi-racial, multi-ethnic coalition.






Today's stock market bears about as much resemblance to the real economy as a game of poker or Monopoly or Trivial Pursuit.

Instead of the market indexes, keep tracking employment, wages, and the gross domestic product (GDP). When they return, we will have recovered. Not Before


The stock market may be a game but it is being played with dollars. The rise in stock prices without an increase in productivity or dividends is not and indication of growth but of inflation and instability!

The leading indicators for Texas are down 4.6%





The book's protagonist, Zarathustra, contends that "man is something which ought to be overcome:"

All beings so far have created something beyond themselves; and do you want to be the ebb of this great flood and even go back to the beasts rather than overcome man? What is the ape to man? A laughingstock or a painful embarrassment. And man shall be just that for the overman: a laughingstock or a painful embarrassment...

There is no consensus regarding the precise meaning of the Übermensch, or even the overall importance of the concept in Nietzsche's thought.

Map of Nuclear Power Plants in North America



Total = 99.305 Quadrillion Btu


Total = 7.301 Quadrillion Btu
