


All 435 Members of House of Representatives and 33 Senators will be elected or re-elected.

All 150 Members of Texas House of Representatives and 31 Texas Senators will e elected or re-elected. One-half of the Senate membership is elected every two years in even-numbered years, with the exception that all 31 Senate seats are up for election for the first legislature following the decennial census in order to reflect the newly redrawn districts. After the initial election, the Senate is divided y lot into two classes, with one class having a re-election after two years and the other having a re-election after four years.

The Texas Senate has approved <u>SJR 13</u>, a constitutional amendment which would allow voters to place <u>term limits</u> on certain statewide officeholders. The bill, passed by a 27-4 margin with <u>four Republicans</u> dissenting in the Senate, would limit statewide officeholders to serve 2 consecutive terms. It exempts judicial offices (the 18 elected members of the Texas Supreme Court and Court of Criminal Appeals). The amendment would allow for nonconsecutive terms and would expire in 2031.

While the Senate's <u>SJR 13</u> doesn't have a direct companion on the House side, State Rep. Lyle Larson (R-San Antonio) and State Rep. Patricia Harless (R-Spring) have introduced <u>HJR 42</u>, which would establish a 12-year limit for both statewide officeholders and (unlike SJR 13) for members of the Texas Legislature.

HJR 42 has been assigned to the state affairs committee, where it was left as pending business after a short hearing on February 27.





START Background Report: Boston Marathon Bombings

Data on history of terrorism in Boston, coordinated attacks in US, terrorist attacks on marathons

COLLEGE PARK, Md. – (April 16, 2013) – In light of the series of bombs that exploded near the finish line at the Boston Marathon on April 15, the University of Maryland's National Consortium for the Study of Terrorism and Responses to Terrorism (START) has compiled data on the history of terrorism in Boston, Massachusetts, terrorist usage of coordinated attacks in the United States, and terrorist attacks at previous marathons around the world.

The START Background Report is available for download at http://start.umd.edu/start/publications /br/STARTBackgroundReport_BostonMarathon2013.pdf.

Quick facts from the report:

- > There have been 2,362 terrorist attacks in the United States between 1970 and 2011
- > Sixteen terrorist attacks have occurred in Boston since 1970, but only three since 1990.
- > Boston has been the 14th most frequently targeted U.S. city by terrorists in the past 40 years.
- > There have been two fatal terrorist attacks in Boston since 1970, both classified as assassinations.
- ► Historically, each U.S. terrorist attack has resulted in 3.3 casualties on average. Excluding the 9/11 attacks, the average number of casualties per U.S. attack drops to 1.4 casualties per attack.
- There have been 28 terrorist attacks in the United States since 1970 known to have resulted in more than 10 casualties.
- > Of the 2,362 attacks in the United States between 1970 and 2011, 300 qualify as part of a multiple attack.




Greater Boston Area

Watertown is marked with the "A"



Boston Marathon Course









North Korean exiles scoff at talk of war

Now, amid international fears that North Korea may be preparing for another missile test, and repeated warnings from Pyongyang that it will destroy its enemies, she simply scoffs. The exiles have seen life in both Koreas, and are unimpressed with what they left behind.

"It's not even possible for North Korea to have a war," said the woman, who spent years arranging black market deals for bronze smuggled to China. She asked that her name and other identifying details not be used, to protect relatives still living in the North.

"They don't have fuel. They don't have electricity," she said. "Even if they yell to the world that they'll go to war, it's all just talk."

An influential group of foreign policy thinkers sees the possibly imminent overthrow of Saddam Hussein as just one early step in an ambitious blueprint to spread democracy throughout the world and eliminate threats to the United States.

Although they developed their thinking long before the Sept. 11 attacks, the strategists, often called neoconservatives or neocons, have increased their influence over the Bush administration since Sept. 11, many foreign policy analysts say.

Critics argue that the neocon ideas, including "regime change," are a recipe for perpetual war, because they would steer the United States into many confrontations.

There would be a long list of regimes to be changed.

But the neocons themselves and their supporters say that the United States has an unprecedented historical opportunity to reshape the world in ways that will make our country safer and the rest of the world freer. The neocons, who sometimes call themselves neo- Reaganites, say the key concept is not perpetual war but "moral clarity backed by military strength."

How it looks now to Weber

Last week I called my friend Vin Weber, who has often provided a civil, thoughtful Republican view to journalists in need of one. I asked him how those ideas and impulses look to him 10 years later, with the benefit of the Iraq War experience. His response began:

"Well, I certainly don't wish that Saddam Hussein was still in power in Iraq."

The war and the occupation of Iraq were "handled badly," Weber conceded, and "we didn't need to do it when we did it," but the Mideast is better off with Saddam gone.





The Middle Class Is roke: Pew Study Reveals Real Prolem With Economy

One of the most important stories in the U.S. economy these days is the rise of extreme inequality.

Over the past 30 years, a <u>larger and larger portion of America's income growth has</u> <u>gone to those in the top 10%</u> of incomes, and especially those in the top 1%. This is a major change from the prior 60 years, in which the top 10% and the ottom 90% shared in the income gains.


A stark and startling example of this trend is the fact that, adjusted for inflation, "average hourly earnings" in this country have not increased in 50 years.

A recent Pew study confirms that America's middle class has recently experienced a "lost decade."

Since 2000, the Pew says, "the middle class has shrunk in size, fallen ackward in income and wealth, and shed some—ut y no means all—of its characteristic faith in the future." Pew cites statistics showing that middle class earnings and net worth have plummeted since the mid-2000s and that aout 85% of the middle class say it is harder to maintain their standard of living than it was 10 years ago.

Collectively, the middle class represents enormous uying and spending power, and in the past 60 years this spending power has helped the U.S. economy ecome the envy of the world.

Authority and Knowledge:

You can e considered an authority for thousands of characteristics:

It can e ecause you are a good listener, or ecause you react calmly and softly to others' fragilities, or ecause you are good at saying, "No," or ecause you have no fears, or ecause you veralize and oserve your emotions...

If you are an individual who is very much identified with your ego, you will recognize authority to egotistic people.

If you are an individual who prefers to connect to the Source, to the I Am, you will recognize authority in spiritual people, for example, ut not in egotistic people.

Authority and Knowledge:

Your knowledge is your aility to master <u>Instruction on Matter</u>. People will like your knowledge in Economy, or in Finance, or in Law, or in Philosophy, or in Engineering , or in Astrology, or in Painting...

This means authority does not claim for oedience, never!

Only someone who feels that his authority may e at stake will claim for oedience thru the use of power.

You do not have authority. You are seen as an authority.


The big difference between the External Power and Authority lies in the fact that authority cannot be imposed, it needs to be recognized.



Basic Wilderness Survival Skills From: British Columbia Outdoor Wilderness Guide

Fear - For anyone faced with a wilderness emergency survival situation, fear is a normal reaction. Unless an emergency situation has been anticipated, fear is generally followed by panic then pain, cold, thirst, hunger, fatigue, boredom and loneliness. It is extremely important to calmly assess the situation and not allow these seven enemies to interfere with your survival.


Pain - Pain may often e ignored in a panic situation. Remember to deal with injuries immediately before they become even more serious.

Cold - Cold lowers the ability to think, numbing the body and reducing the will to survive. Never allow yourself to stop moving or to fall asleep unless adequately sheltered. **Thirst** - Dehydration is a common enemy in an emergency situation and must not be ignored. It can dull your mind, causing you to overlook important survival information.

Hunger - Hunger is dangerous but seldom deadly. It may reduce your ability to think logically and increase your susceptibility to the effects of cold, pain and fear.






